

## 2020 INTERNATIONAL HORSERADISH FESTIVAL

### Family Fun Area Vendor Application



Thank you for your interest in the 33<sup>rd</sup> annual International Horseradish Festival! With possible attendance of up to **25,000 visitors**, you are positioned better than ever to showcase your crafts. The Festival will be open Friday, June 5th, 11 am – 10 pm; Saturday, June 6th, 10 am – 10 pm. Vendors will be open for business during all hours previously listed unless they are given permission to leave due to inclement weather.

Vendor move-in and set-up will be Thursday evening from 6 pm until 10 pm, & Friday before 9 am. Note: All vendors must adhere to set-up schedules due to road / festival closures for safety and security. Absolutely no vehicles allowed to enter/exit from festival grounds once street closures are in place. If you have not participated in the past or if your items have changed, provide two photos along with complete size / dimensions and electrical requirement for review by the Festival Executive Committee. The Executive Committee reserves the right to accept vendors and assign spaces. All booths include access to standard 110v electricity. Vendor to supply their own 3-prong, 100' extension cords. Note: 220v is not available. Only festival approved generators allowed with prior approval in writing. Festival is not liable for any electrical issues on site. City staff and festival site staff will be available but are not responsible for vendor electric.

Due to space constraints, limited electricity, the committee reserves the right to deny application at which time payment and application will be returned. Vendor fees are required to be submitted with this application. Checks may be post dated May 1, 2020, and will be held until that date. ACTIVITY INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

This agreement made by and between the International Horseradish Festival Committee (IHFC), Collinsville Chamber of Commerce, Inc. (CofC), and (hereinafter Indemnitor):
